

## **Total Swine Genetics – Entry Requirements for Incoming Boars**

### Entrance requirements for boars:

#### **PRRS:**

Negative ELISA and PCR – this test must be done during on-farm testing for AI. Herds that routinely test PRRS ELISA should supply information on current PRRS ELISA test results.

If PRRS ELISA testing is not routinely performed, two ELISA tests will be required, one month apart.

### Supplying Herd Definitions:

Naive: Never exposed to PRRS

Negative: Herd returned to negative status. 18 month history of negative testing, at least quarterly. Individuals tested as per requirements (negative ELISA and PCR on farm at time of CFIA testing).

#### **Mycoplasma:**

Current herd history and vaccination status.

#### **APP:**

Negative test – twice yearly testing.

No history of exposure/positive testing unless proven to be cross reaction (ie A. porcitonisillaris)

Multi APP test at Biovet should be used OR test serotypes 1, 5, 7 at U of Montreal.

#### **SUPPLYING HERD HEALTH HISTORY:**

Brief documentation twice yearly from herd vet regarding overall health status of herd. See Supplying Herd Health Form.

#### **FEDERAL TESTING**

TGE testing on farm

## **VACCINATION – ON FARM (ELIGIBLE BOARS)**

### *Permissible vaccines:*

- ⇒ Influenza
- ⇒ Circovirus
- ⇒ Farrowsure B
- ⇒ Mycoplasma

### *Prohibited vaccines:*

- ⇒ PRRS
- ⇒
- ⇒ APP

## **ISOLATION VACCINATION SCHEDULE:**

- ⇒ Mycoplasma/Influenza combination (twice)
- ⇒ Farrowsure B (twice)
- ⇒ Circovirus (Circoflex)

## **DEWORMING:**

- ⇒ Atgard C

## **TREATMENT ON ENTRY TO ISOLATION:**

Federal Requirement: Tetracycline long-acting for treatment of leptospirosis.
